



Camp Discovery

GENERAL INFORMATION

Check in (8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.)

MONDAYS ONLY: Check in at Information Desk

Monday afternoon through Friday a parent or guardian will be expected to sign in their child at the front table located inside the front doors of the Museum. You may temporarily park your car in the bus loop located on SW 5TH Avenue for drop off and pick up. A child may participate in Camp Discovery programs only when camp fees are processed and the following camp forms are completed:

- Registration Form
- Code of Conduct Form
- Camp Policy and Emergency Form
- Subway Lunch Request (**optional**)

Check-Out (4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.)

Any child being checked in or out between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. must go to the Information Desk. Each afternoon, after 5:00 p.m., check out will be at the camp table located inside the exit door in front of the museum. A parent or guardian must present a photo ID and sign the log sheet at the Camp Discovery check out table located with the camp. Only adults indicated on the Camp Policy and Emergency Information Form will be allowed to check out a camper. **(NO EXCEPTIONS)**

Before (8:00-9:00 a.m.) and After care (5:00-6:00 p.m.)

A daily fee of \$5 is charged per child for before/after care and may include Museum exploration, science games, and puzzles. **An additional fee of \$10 per child for each additional 5 minutes of care will be charged after 6:00 p.m.**

Lunches and Snacks

Campers may bring their own bag lunches that do not require refrigeration or indicate their preference for a Subway "camper's lunch pack" **at the time of registration**. A simple snack and water will be provided twice a day. Campers may also bring snacks from home, especially if they have dietary restrictions including kosher. **Please do not send money for snack machines.**

Contacting your child during Camp Discovery

If you have an emergency and need to contact your child during camp hours, please call 954.467.6637 ext. 104 for our security office ext. 207 for the Camp Director or ext. 300 to reach the reservations department. If a parent would like a direct line to contact camp, then the Camp Director will provide it to you at the time of check-in.

What to wear and what to bring

Campers should wear comfortable clothing that is suitable for indoors, outdoors and getting dirty. Shorts and t-shirts are recommended. Sneakers or closed-toe shoes are required. No shoes with wheels, please. Children should be prepared to spend short periods of time outside and participate daily in physical activity. It is recommended that children bring insect repellent, sunblock and a plastic water bottle.

What not to bring

Cash, toys, electronics, gameboys and other valuables should not be brought to Camp. The Museum is not responsible for any personal items that are lost or stolen.

Friday is Explore Store Day

Campers will have an opportunity to visit the Explore Store on Friday morning. If you'd like your child to visit the Store, please give them a little money to spend when you drop them off on Friday. If you select not to have them participate we will provide another activity for them.
