



Programs

- Almost 90,000 people visited the Museum on organized tours and field trips.
- 7,489 students attended Museum labs and demos designed to augment classroom curriculum and complement our films and exhibits.
- 8,971 students were served by the Museum-on-wheels school outreach program.
- Museum's education staff trained 125 Broward County school teachers in science curriculum development, hands-on activities and teaching techniques in the subject areas of early childhood education, physical and biological science.
- 24 Real Time Science Connections television programs featured Museum educators and exhibits on the Broward County Schools BECON television network and local cable channels during the school year.
- The Munson Foundation funded the Museum's participation in a three year partnership with Everglades National Park and the Florida Aquarium to deliver Everglades programming to teachers and students.
